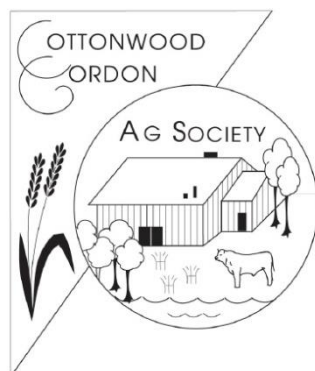

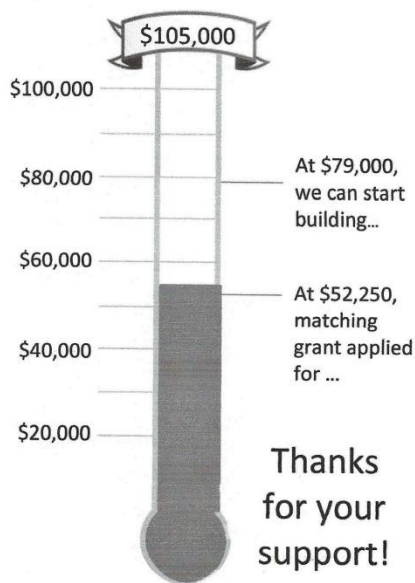
Saturday March 16 or April 13- non-restricted, starts @ 8am (minimum age 12)
