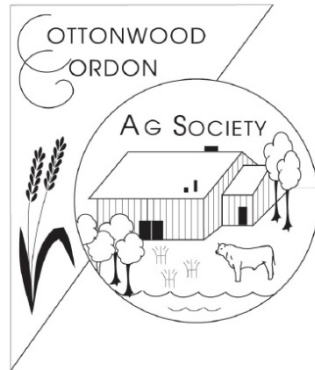

and a Lunch BBQ.

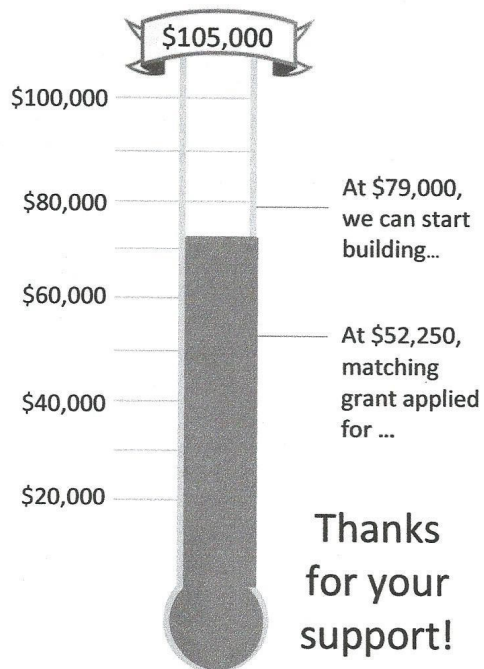
This year we will have some new entertainment- Come See
