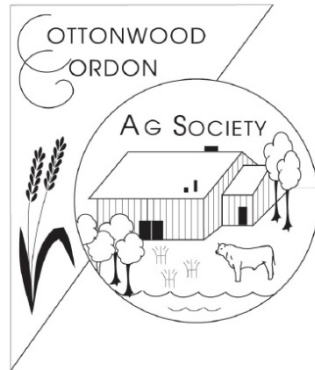

**The project is progressing well. We greatly appreciate the help of all who have come out to volunteer their time and labour. If you've been by the Hall lately, you will have seen what's happening.**

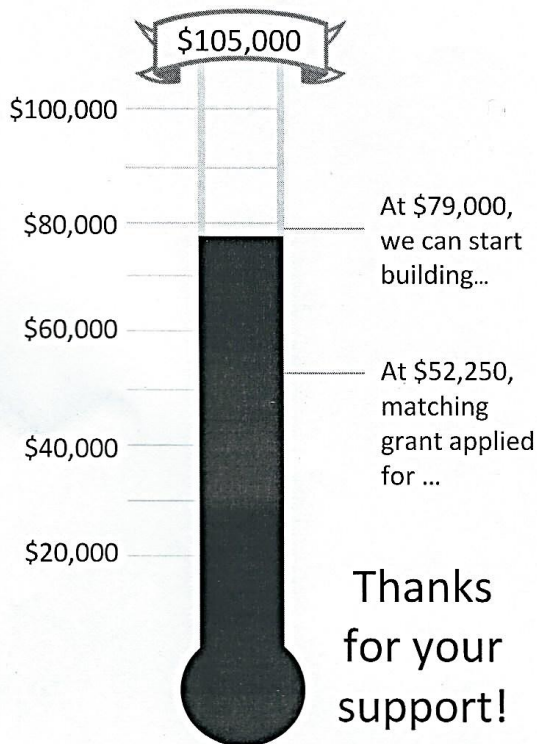
